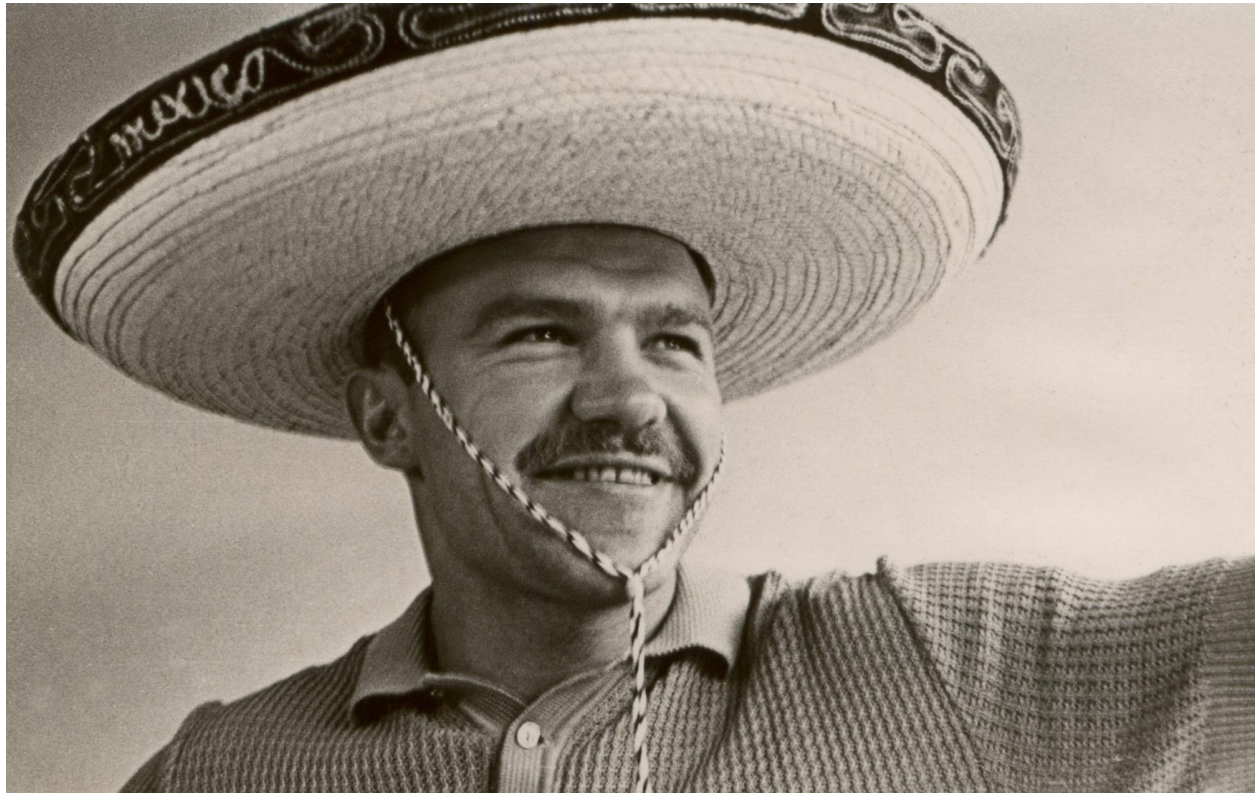

# INVITATION

**XIV International "Danas Pozniakas" Youth Boxing Tournament** will be held on **19<sup>th</sup>-24<sup>th</sup> March, 2019** in Vilnius, Lithuania.

Hereby we have the great pleasure to invite your National Association/Federation to participate in the Tournament.

For teams (max. 9 persons per team: 6 boxers + 3 officials) and for non AIBA R/J organizers will provide accommodation & meals during the Tournament days **for price 50 euros per day per person.**

The host will provide accommodation & meals for **only** AIBA R/J.

For additional persons organizers will provide accommodation & meals for price **80 euros** per day per person.

For those teams members coming before 19<sup>th</sup> March and leaving after 24<sup>th</sup> March, organizers will provide accommodation & meals for price **80 euros** per day per person.

"Danas Pozniakas" Youth Boxing Tournament will be held at the University of Educational Sciences Grand Hall, Studentu str. 39.

Accommodation and meals will be at the Hotel "EuropaCity Vilnius", J. Jasinskio str. 14.

We await your preliminary numerical entries by **16<sup>th</sup> February** (application form is attached).

Final entries with categories, names, total number of the delegation members and travel details must be sent at the latest by **1<sup>th</sup> March.**

# REGULATIONS

The competition will be held according to the rules of AIBA (10 weight categories, from light flyweight 49 kg to super heavyweight +91 kg).

The competition is open for athletes born from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2001 to 31<sup>th</sup> December 2002.

Each National Association/Federation may nominate one boxer for each of the 10 weight categories. The organizer takes 16 boxers in each weight category.

## **The teams and their attendants according to the following rule:**

1-2 boxers      + 2 attendants  
3-6 boxers      + 3 attendants              + 1 AIBA R/J 1-3 Stars

## **Payment of Hotel Room Charges:**

All delegations must pay the full room charges (accommodation & meal) in advance at the time of check-in by cash.

Team Delegations will not be able to receive accreditation cards and hotel room keys if the payment is not made in full.

Please note that every boxer is requested to show his international (AIBA) competition record book at the first weight-in. Every boxer has to bring a red and blue competition uniform.

Please note if the boxer is European, the European Health Insurance Card is required.

The referee/judge must be recognized by AIBA and must show an international record book before the beginning of the competition.
