The Boxing Federation of India, with great pleasure and honor, cordially invites your Elite Men's and Women's Boxing team to participate in the **2nd India Open International Boxing Tournament** from May 20th to 24th May, 2019 to be held in Guwahati, Assam-INDIA.

BFI recently organized AIBA Women's World Boxing Championship at New Delhi, India from 14th to 24th November, 2018. This Championship was a great success and was lauded by all the participating countries and the AIBA delegates as well. Earlier in November, 2017, BFI also conducted very successfully the AIBA Youth Women's World Championship at Guwahati, the city in which the present Tournament is being organized.

The terms and conditions of participation as well as schedule of activities of the tournament are mentioned below:

5. Number of Rounds

Elite Men: Three (3) rounds of three (3) minutes, one (1) minute rest between rounds. Elite Women: Three (3) rounds of three (3) minutes, one (1) minute rest between rounds.

6. Referees & Judges

Referees & Judges (AIBA R&J with 1-2-3 stars only) can be sent with their team. Travel expenses to be borne by respective Federation. Boarding and Lodging will be borne by BFI.

7. Team composition

- Each team can have the maximum of 20 boxers and 06 Officials, excluding Referee and Judge. Other team members will be count as Extra members. Extra charged will be applicable.

8. Requirements

A. All Boxers must bring the following documents:

- Boxer's AIBA Competition Record Book with annual medicals duly completed
- Passport
- Declaration of Non-Pregnancy form (for women athletes)

B. Boxer's Uniform:

- Each boxer must bring two sets of uniform – red and blue
- All uniforms must follow the AIBA uniform guidelines in the Rules.

9. Transportation

Local Transportation will be provided by the Organizers to and from the airport as well as from hotel to the competition venue and back. However, the transportation from respective country to Guwahati and back will be the responsibility of participating country. International connecting flights to Guwahati are via New Delhi and Kolkata.

10. Accommodation for Team Delegations

- Twin room (2 persons per room/night), including 3 meals – 40 USD/per night/per person
- Single room (1 person per night), including 3 meals - as per availability – 65 USD per night/per person

11. Insurance

All participants are requested to get their own travel and medical insurance. LOC will provide liability insurance only at the Competition Venue for all participants.
